- Put forth my best effort each day.
- Respect myself, others, and property.
- Ask questions in school if I don't understand.
- Listen carefully and follow directions and the school rules.
- Be involved in reading, writing, and problem solving.
- Share my school work, notes, newsletters, and communicate with my family daily.
- Talk about what I learned at school.
- Complete my homework daily and turn it in the following day.
